- I, Benedict Johnson, declare as follows:
- 1. I make this statement on the basis of my personal knowledge and, if called as a witness, could and would testify as to its contents. I am a Class Representative in this lawsuit.
- 2. Since retaining Medina Orthwein LLP and Lieff, Cabraser, Heimann & Bernstein, LLP (collectively "Class Counsel"), I have stayed in regular contact with my attorneys regarding the status of the case. Class Counsel have also consulted me throughout the investigation, prosecution of claims, and settlement discussions with the Defendants.
- 3. I understand the responsibilities of a Class Representative and I have fulfilled, and I continue to fulfill, my duties to the Class. I have been actively involved in all aspects of this case, as described more fully below. On many occasions, I have provided Class Counsel with input and advice regarding various aspects of company practices and facts supporting legal claims, as well as potential interventions such as those reflected in the terms of the settlement. I have vigorously represented the Class's interests pursuant to my fiduciary duties to the Class I represent.
- 4. I was not promised any amount of money to serve as a Class Representative, or in connection with my approval of this settlement or any prior settlement with Defendants. My approval of this Settlement is based on my view, in light of the record and the risks, that it is in the best interests of the Class.
- 5. Class Counsel consulted me about the settlement negotiations with Defendants as they occurred, and I authorized my attorneys in these negotiations. I authorized this proposed settlement with the Defendants for over \$11.5 million, and I believe that the proposed settlement is fair, adequate, and reasonable.

## Benefits to the Class From My Actions as a Class Representative

- 6. In my role as Class Representative, I have expended substantial time and effort (as more fully explained below) to perform actions that have benefited the Class at large.
- 7. Since I first retained Class Counsel in March 2019, I have spent well over 150 hours fulfilling my role as a Class Representative in this case, including participating in informal discovery and mediation. A summary of my activities is as follows:
